

Saving Pictures to Your Computer - XP

Make a new folder:

Double click on “My Documents”.

Double click on “My Pictures”.

On left pane click on “Make a new folder”.

Type in name of folder (Example: Christmas 04; a name of event of something to identify group of pictures.)

Click anywhere on white area.

Copying Pictures Using Microsoft Scanner & Camera Wizard – XP

After inserting memory card into memory card reader and waiting a few minutes a window will come up with several choices. Choose or click on:

“Copy pictures to a folder on my computer using Microsoft Scanner & Camera Wizard”

A Scanner & Camera Wizard window will come up.

Click on Next.

Check to see if all selections are checked in upper right hand corner of each picture or uncheck the ones you don't want. It may be easier to use the “Clear all” button and then go back and check the ones you want.

Click on Next.

Type in name you want to call them. It might match folder to which they are being stored such as: Christmas 04

Hit the “Browse” button to find correct folder.

Highlight or click on the correct folder.

Click on Ok.

Check to be sure information is correct

Click on Next.

Computer uploads pictures to folder.

You will get a window that asks you, "What do you want to do?"

Make sure the button is highlighted that says, "Nothing I'm finished working with these pictures."

Click on Next.

You'll see a window that says, "Completing the Scanner & Camera Wizard."

Click on Finish

Computer opens to folder with names of pictures.

Double click on name of picture to see or open it.
