

## Steady State Program Outline

Setup a new user account that can be used by other people using your computer.

If they are frequent users warn them that they must save files to portable media. Changes will not be saved on your computer.

Install Steady State and configure it.

Click getting started tab on left side of configuration window for help.

Look at configuration window and go over the different options.

If you turn on “Protect The Hard Disk”, no changes under any user including **you** will be saved unless you tell it to save them. Any names under user settings does not have the option to save changes.

Test the restrictions you enable to see if those are the settings you want. Try only one or two at a time and remember what you did so it can be undone. (You must log on as the “other User” to test the restrictions”.

When “Protect The Hard Drive “ is enabled and **you** tell the computer to save the changes, when starting the computer it is a slow process.

With Disk Protection on you need to schedule updates through the Steady State program. Otherwise the updates will be erased.

Hard Disk Protection must be turned off to install or uninstall software.

Remove all the restrictions you put in before uninstalling. The changes will stall after the program is gone.

Show the guest user after changes are made.

Log on as administrator and show how saving changes works.
