Download Steady State from Microsoft at <http://www.microsoft.com/windows/products/winfamily/sharedaccess/default.msp>
Scroll down and then follow the links. Also search www.google.com typing steady state in the search box, then follow the links. The download is 6.35mb in size. There is also a Steady State handbook in PDF format that you can download. There is good information in the handbook about using Steady State.

Before you can download Steady State Microsoft will want to validate your copy of Windows. This is okay and harmless.

Before installing Steady State I recommend creating a new user id. The new user will give you a user account to control and allow guest user a logon onto your computer.

When you set restrictions in Steady State, try one restriction at a time. Then test the results of your settings. Remember what you did so it can be undone if you do not like the results. This is a powerful program and can cause you great pain or pleasure when you set restrictions.

I have noticed a small slow down in the performance of my computer when using an account with restrictions. Also saving your changes is a little slow.
